Antiterrorism

- “Empowered, not impaired; Aware, not afraid”
- No change to current threat. Maintain vigilance at large gatherings
- Enhanced support to DoDEA
 - ❖ Bus Route Risk Assessments
 - ❖ Bus Shock Exercises
 - ❖ Tabletop Exercise with Host Nation agencies
 - ❖ Increased ID checks on buses arriving to Hohenfels
 - ❖ Reviewed school emergency plans and evaluated drills
 - ❖ “Trip Talk” briefing points for events/trips

Emergency Management

- AtHoc Registration
 - ❖ ~7,000 personnel in Hohenfels with 4,025 AtHoc end-users
 - ❖ Garrison cannot reach 3,400 users once they leave their desk!
 - ❖ ~3,500 users cannot be reached after duty hours
 - ❖ Only 3 people have registered for the AtHoc Notifier Application
- Sponsored Accounts
 - ❖ 167 Family Member Accounts

Security

- Background check process for Contractors and Volunteers working with Children
 - ❖ **Requirement:** Investigative requirements are mandated by DoD and Army policy for all personnel working with children, no waivers allowed
 - ❖ **Process:** Starts with your Program Manager who must request the investigation. The Program Manager will decide when you can begin working

DES

Winter Driving

- Winter Tires
 - ❖ Must have the “Snowflake” logo or “M+S” Symbol
 - ❖ Tread must have a minimum of 1.6 mm depth
 - ❖ No mandatory calendar date for usage
 - ❖ Law states – for black ice, snow, slush, ice conditions
 - ❖ Could be fined and/or held liable for accidents
- Window Washer
 - ❖ Must have antifreeze washer fluid
- Snow on Car
 - ❖ All snow must be removed from vehicle
 - ❖ All windows must be clear



DES

Winter Driving

- **TMP Requirements**

- ❖ Must complete winter driving training provided by the unit
- ❖ Training can be obtained through the TMP
- ❖ Training must be documented annually
- ❖ Must have winter driving stamp on license
- ❖ Vehicles will not be dispatched under certain road conditions
- ❖ Vehicles will not be dispatched without winter driving stamp
- ❖ Vehicles cannot be operated without winter driving stamp
- ❖ From 31 OCT to 15 APR


