

- HQDA EXORD 191-16 Realigns the Army Substance Abuse Program (ASAP) Clinical Treatment and Rehabilitation Care to USMEDCOM Behavioral Health System of Care (BHSOC)
- Effective 1 October 2016 IMCOM transferred mission command of ASAP treatment and rehabilitation capabilities to MEDCOM.
- The relocation and transfer includes resources, personnel, manpower requirements and manpower authorizations
- Deterrence/drug testing and prevention/training continue as part of IMCOM
- For Commanders this transition should be seamless
- Referrals utilizing DA Form 8003 will continue

Child Supervision Policy

Newborns-4years of age

- Cannot be left at home alone
- Cannot be left outside unattended
- Cannot be left in a vehicle unattended
For any length of time, for any reason

Children Ages 5-6

- Cannot be left home alone
- Cannot be left in a vehicle unattended
- Cannot babysit siblings or other children
- May walk to and from school at age 6
- May play outside at a playground or yard that is within visual and hearing distance of adult supervision

Children Ages 7-9

- Cannot be left home alone
- Cannot babysit siblings or other children
- May walk to and from school
- May play outside at a playground or yard that is within visual and hearing distance of adult supervision
- May be left in a vehicle with the keys removed for 10 minutes within sight of adult supervision
except in hot weather

Children Ages 10-11

- Cannot be left at home alone overnight
- 10 yr. olds cannot babysit siblings or other children
- 11 yr. olds may babysit for up to 2 hours
- May be left at home for up to 6 hours with phone access to an adult to supervise
- May be outside/play outside unattended
- May be left in a vehicle unattended with the keys removed

Children Ages 12-14

- Cannot be left at home alone overnight
- May be left at home for up to 6 hours with phone access to an adult to supervise
- May be outside/play outside unattended
- May be left in a vehicle unattended with the keys removed
- May babysit siblings and other children for up to 3 hours and based on country specific guidance

Children Ages 15-17

- May be left alone at home to include overnight
- May be outside unattended at age 15 as long as they have access to an adult and their sponsor is in the local area. For children ages 16-17 cannot be left alone for more than 5 consecutive days. Parents must designate an adult as a point of contact that will make daily face-to-face contact
- May be left in a vehicle unattended
- May babysit siblings and other children

NOTES:

- Parents must make an informed choice (for example, regarding heat, level of danger, amount of time) when carrying groceries from the car to inside or when doing laundry, or leaving the child home alone.
- Adult Supervision is defined as "someone who has or assumes responsibility for the child (for example a parent, guardian, care provider or friend)."
- Since each child is unique, parents are responsible for assessing the individual capabilities of their children.
- Red Cross or Child Youth Services babysitting training is *strongly recommended* for any child who wishes to babysit.
- Children enrolled in DODDS Kindergarten, regardless of their age must be accompanied by a parent or designated caregiver when walking to and from school or a bus stop and while waiting at a bus stop.


