

MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Bavaria Military Community Policy Letter #46; AAFES Exchange Privilege Suspension

1. **Effective Date.** This policy letter remains in effect until superseded or recinded.
2. **Scope.** This policy letter is applicable to all persons afforded Exchange privileges within the Bavaria Military Community.
3. **Purpose.** Ensure good order and discipline in the Bavaria Military Community, and prevent abuse of AAFES privileges in accordance with AR 215-8.
4. **Policy.** Upon receipt of credible information that an individual with AAFES privileges has committed the offense of larceny of AAFES property, the individual will have their AAFES privileges immediately suspended by the Provost Marshal's Office, pending the final outcome of investigation by the Provost Marshal Office and adjudication of the offense by the individuals Commander or the Civilian Misconduct Action Authority (CMAA). Individuals found not guilty by their Commander or the CMAA will have their AAFES privileges reinstated. Individuals found by their Commander or the CMAA to have committed the offense of larceny of AAFES property will have their AAFES privileges revoked across the Bavaria Military Community for a minimum of six (6) months. Individuals that have had their AAFES privileges revoked may appeal the revocation to the Garrison Commander revoking the privileges or the next higher Commander in accordance with AR 215-8 paragraph 7-6e.
