MEMORANDUM FOR All USAG Bavaria Soldiers, DA Civilians, and Family Members

SUBJECT: USAG Bavaria Policy Letter #20; Installation Curfew

1. The following curfew is in effect and applies to all USAG Bavaria communities.

a. Juveniles between the ages of 13-15 must be inside their quarters by 2200 hours Sunday through Thursday unless in the presence of their sponsor, adult Family member, or designated adult guardian. Curfew on Friday and Saturday is extended to 2300 hours. For the purpose of this policy, an adult is defined as someone who is 18 years or older. For juveniles under the age of 13 the child supervision guidelines apply.

b. Juveniles who are 16-17 must be inside their quarters by 2300 hours Sunday through Thursday unless in the presence of their sponsor, adult Family member, or designated adult guardian. Curfew on Friday and Saturday is extended to 2400 hours.

c. Exceptions to the above rules will be granted for specifically sanctioned activities such as DoDDS, youth services, employment, MWR events, or Chapel youth ministries. Juveniles returning from these types of sponsored activities must go directly to their quarters upon completion of the activity. Military police may temporarily detain the minor to contact their parents for verification of employment or activity.

d. Any juvenile found in violation of this curfew will be escorted to the Military Police (MP) station. Parents will be called to retrieve the child(ren) from the MP station. The juvenile will be immediately released to the parents unless there is ancillary misconduct committed during the curfew violation.

2. Service members under the age of 18 are not subject to the terms of this curfew regulation.

3. This policy is applicable to all juveniles, other than military Service members in the USAG Bavaria area of responsibility. The policy applies to dependents of military and/or DOD civilian personnel assigned to USAREUR or are in the legal custody of USAREUR military or DOD civilian personnel (e.g., guardianship or foster care); live on – or off-post. Failure to comply with the provisions of this policy letter may result in adverse administrative action or punitive action against any person in the categories above, including Civilian Misconduct Action Authority (CMAA) and/or early return of dependants for civilian Family members.
